CHALLENGES

The Information Technology (IT) department of the City of West Linn started a new project to replace all of their existing PC computers. The licensing of the existing PDF software was tied to initial purchase of the hardware, so the change of equipment would result in the loss of these software licenses. Therefore, as part of the project, it was necessary to acquire a new PDF solution.

The IT team started by evaluating all major PDF providers. The previous PDF provider was the first option considered, but it was discarded due to its high cost. "We continued searching for an alternative PDF solution that was cost effective and could minimize the gap between our organization's needs and the budget. It was crucial for us to find a balance of features, quality, and price and standardize on a single solution," said Shane Boyle, Chief Information Officer for the City of West Linn.

The City of West Linn, Oregon, incorporated in 1913, provides needed services, utilities, and infrastructure to the citizens of West Linn. In addition, the City of West Linn had a goal to automate their process and document management to become a paperless office. The process of printing records and keeping them in physical folders was old-fashioned and highly time consuming for the organization; so, the objective was to start to convert and archive documents electronically.
